Two main purposes in life

Destitute Children &

India.

She trained as a teacher - 1835-

Founded a "Working & Visiting
 Society"

Opened a Ragged School . _____ 1846
 in Bristol

Boys & Girls Reformatories 1852-54
 (two)

Promoted the Industrial Schools Act

& got additional amendments 1857
 carried in 1861 . 1866.

She originated Feeding of Children
 in schools - which was embodied
 in Act of 1876 for industrial schools

Founded also National Indian
Association & edited its journal

Appointed for Rescue
Institution for
Juvenile Criminals

Founded a Ragged School 1846

Girls Reformatory 1852

Industrial School 1859.

Visited India to improve Education
of women and Person Management

1866 - 1868 - 1869 - 1875-

visited Germany 1872 & America 1873

Published tracts, verses &
memoirs on education of the reform
ed treatment of criminals.
