FRANCE

1. Act: White Lead

Loi du 31 janvier 1926 modifiant le chapitre IV du titre II du livre II du code du travail (dispositions spéciales à l'emploi de la céruse dans les travaux de peinture). (Journal officiel du 1er et 2 février 1926, no. 27, p. 1490.)

Act to amend chapter IV of Title II of Book II of the Labour Code (special provisions respecting the use of white lead in painting work). Dated 31st January, 1926.

1. The heading of chapter IV of Title II of Book II of the Code of Labour and Social Welfare shall be amended to read as follows:—

“Special provisions relating to the use of lead compounds in painting work.”

2. Section 79 of Book II of the Code of Labour and Social Welfare shall be amended to read as follows:—

“79. The use of white lead, lead sulphate and linseed oil containing lead, and of any specially prepared product containing white lead or lead sulphate, shall be prohibited in all painting work, irrespective of its nature, carried out on the exterior and interior of buildings.”

3. The last paragraph of section 173 of Book II of the Code of Labour and Social Welfare shall be amended to read as follows:—

“Any person guilty of contravening the provisions of sections 66 *b* and 79 of this Book shall be liable to the same penalties under the same conditions. Nevertheless, the said penalties shall not apply if the painting work covered by section 79 is carried out by the proprietor or tenant of the buildings himself.”
