Dear Miss Phillips,

I write to correct a careless mistake in my letter of September 23rd giving an account of the Parliamentary Divisions in which the London Society is collecting information. Will you be so kind as to destroy that letter and substitute this one in its place.

My Committee accepted the suggestion of the National Union that the London Societies should be responsible for the collection of information in the constituencies within the area of its branch Societies and Local Committees. It has therefore undertaken the 59 constituencies within the County of London and in addition the following constituencies in the Home Counties -
