pro. tem. who would be
an admirable secretary if

encouraged. So I do not
know if you can do anything
towards that. Miss Wyse
knows another lady, but
she would require ¹³ a
week, and at present funds
are naturally low.

The Burkehead people
had their annual meeting
on Friday. Miss Moper
came to speak to them
about the working
women's need, and a
local Poor Law Guardian

whom they had been
wishing to secure, after
discussing the "Women
Disturbances" with her, beauty
joined the Society.

Miss Koper looked very
ill & coughed severely -
no wonder - she wears
herself out in the cause,
& it grieves me to see her.
