having been back to Berlin from Switzer-
land since August 11th. I am quite alone
here with a servant, and in too great a
hurry with business to write a letter now,

alone, and a foreigner, too. The establishment
is too large for private surveillance ^{and}
intercourse, though excellent otherwise.
My mother & sisters are well, I too. Much
