Ordinance: Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children
(Amendment)

An Ordinance to amend the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1934¹. No. 16 of 1935. Assented to 3rd May, 1935.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935, and shall be read and construed as one with the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1934¹.

2. The Governor in Executive Council may make regulations:—

- (a) defining the line of division which separates industry from commerce and agriculture;
- (b) suspending the prohibition of night work for young persons between the ages of sixteen years and eighteen years when in cases of serious emergency the public interest demands it; and
- (c) in industrial undertakings which are influenced by the seasons and in all cases where exceptional circumstances demand it, reducing the night period for the non-employment of women to ten hours on sixty days of the year.
