of the North London Collegiate

me the other day that she
had heard that there were

more Schemes which might
have been included, & that
under the new régime,
which we feared might be
less favourable to women
than the old, we are
likely to be as well treated
as before. But we must
remember that many of
these Schemes have not yet
become law, & also that
a good deal is left to the

in each case
governors, who will probably
keep down the 'mistresses'
salaries as much as they
can. Still, it is a great
thing to have such things
gravelly proposed by
respectable people.
