I hope our school opening went well today.

Dearest Another messenger is returning to England & is taking our letters. The ordinary post seems very slow still so that it is a great help to have letters personally conducted.

On Tuesday Aunt Joey appeared here. She had taken a long & trouble to find me & I think it was clever of her to do so. I was very glad to see her & to take her round the wards. She brought cigarettes & chocolate for the men & she was a most charming visitor & made a visit to my bed like a princess.

You will be seeing her soon so that I need not give you any of her news. We are having a very busy day - 5 operations already & after dinner we are another trifling - The ambulance has been bringing us in relays of Frenchmen today. Some so ill: all so gentle & sensitive & shocked as our men are physically & mentally.

There has been a domestic upheaval in this hotel today. The manager found that things had been going badly downstairs & wholesale dismissals followed. On the whole we are

very comfortable - & the food is quite good enough - & our bedrooms are nice indeed. This is a stupid little note written in great haste. & now comes the summary for dinner so I must go. Very much love - M. L. G.
