Clinic attendances continue to increase. On the Birth Control side there is a great improvement in the percentage of return visits—until recently this was only about 60 per cent ; it is now over 90 per cent.

There has been a marked increase in the numbers attending the Gynæcological Sessions (from 880 to 1,274) ; a large number of these patients are sent by doctors and welfare centres, and more particularly from the local borough of Kensington by Dr. Violet Russell (assistant M.O.H.) and her staff, with whom close co-operation is maintained.

TALKS TO WOMEN AND GIRLS

The project outlined in the last Report of informal talks to women and girls materialized in December 1936, when four talks were given. The subjects dealt with included various problems of health, sex-education, adolescence, marital relations and preparation for motherhood. The experiment was so much appreciated by the patients that eight more such talks were given in the Spring.



The talks were all opened by women doctors, and the Committee wish to thank Dr. Stella Churchill, Dr. Greta Graff, Dr. Lynette Hemmant, Dr. Laura Hutton and Dr. Jocelyn Moore for the generous and helpful manner in which they have forwarded this scheme.

It is now planned to hold such talks as a regular weekly session ; it is hoped that there will soon be a wide realization of the contribution made by such discussions to the national campaign for physical fitness. The Committee would warmly welcome the co-operation of any friends who are in touch with organizations of young working women.

ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting was held on February 22nd, 1937, in the small Town Hall, Kensington. Lady Maurice took the chair, and the speakers were Mr. Claud Mullins, Mrs. Spring-Rice and Professor James Young of the West London Post-Graduate School of Medicine.

COUNCIL

Miss Madeleine Symons and Mr. Claud Mullins have become members of the Council.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Mr. C. H. Scott, who has been Honorary Treasurer since 1931, has resigned his office during the year. The Committee are deeply grateful for all he has done ; during his treasurership the financial responsibilities have increased in proportion to the growth of the Clinic. Fortunately, Mr. Scott is remaining on the Committee. He is succeeded as Honorary Treasurer by Mr. Roderick Garrett.

Dr. Hislop, through pressure of other work, has resigned from the Committee ; he has been connected with the Clinic since its inception, and for many years has been Chairman of the Medical Committee. His willing help and wise counsel have been of inestimable value.

Other resignations were: Dr. James Fenton, who found it impossible to attend Committee meetings ; Dr. Geffen ;

and Miss Christobel Robinson, who, however, continues her voluntary work at the Clinic.

Two vacancies were filled during the year by Mrs. Bradbury, who lives in North Kensington and Mrs. Patterson, a member of the Paddington Borough Council, both of whom have extensive knowledge of the needs of working women in the district. Owing to the growth of the work of the Clinic, it is now thought desirable to have two Vice-Chairmen. The Committee have appointed Mrs. Marjorie Farrer, (their former Vice-Chairman) and Mrs. Basil Herbert, in place of Mrs. Lloyd, who wished to resign.

MEDICAL COMMITTEE AND MEDICAL STAFF

The Medical Committee have met frequently and kept in close touch with the Clinic organization. Dr. Marjorie Edwards replaces Dr. Hislop as Chairman, and becomes, *ex-officio*, a member of the Executive Committee.

Mr. G. W. Theobald, on relinquishing his appointment at St. Mary Abbot's Hospital, ceased to be Honorary Consultant Gynæcologist to the Clinic ; his place has been taken by Mr. Green-Armytage, whose kindness in undertaking the work is greatly appreciated.

The whole Birth Control movement sustained a great loss by the death, in April last, at a tragically early age, of Dr. Cecile Booyesen. Her inspiring personality and exceptional ability are very greatly missed. Dr. Booyesen was for several years a valued member of the Clinic medical staff, and at the time of her death a member of the Medical Committee.

CLINIC STAFF

The Committee wish to record their deep appreciation of the work of the Clinic staff, Mrs. Wylson and her two assistants, Mrs. Cattran and Mrs. Gwynne ; their enthusiasm and their unfailing response to any calls which may be made upon them are beyond all praise.

THANKS

Mr. H. F. Rubinstein continues most kindly to act as Honorary Solicitor and his valuable help is gratefully

acknowledged. The Clinic is fortunate in being able to count upon the help of many voluntary workers, to all of whom the Committee express their sincere thanks.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The financial position of the Clinic at the end of the year covered by this report was satisfactory. The contributions in respect of Sunday Cinema performances have for the first time been received during the whole financial year, and we wish again to express our gratitude to the Cinemas who assist us so generously.

We also extend our hearty thanks to our other subscribers. We depend very greatly on their help and wish to impress upon them the need for the continuance of their contributions and for the recruiting of new subscribers. The amount received from this source has slightly fallen since last year.

We have now made arrangements by which a subscriber may enter into a seven-year covenant which enables the Clinic to recover Income Tax on the subscription. We hope that many subscribers will take advantage of this obvious means of increasing the value of their contributions.

There is still a mortgage of £400 on the building. It has been thought wise to retain the Clinic's available resources in an easily realisable form rather than to use them in paying off the mortgage, since the latter course would leave the Clinic unprepared for any emergency which may arise.
