LEAGUE OF NATIONS 4 MANDATED TERRITORY OF PALESTINE¹

Ordinance: Employment of Females

An Ordinance to limit the employment of certain females. No. 33 of 1933. Dated 23rd August, 1933.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Employment of Females Ordinance, 1933.

2. Any contract made prior to the commencement of this Ordinance whereby it was agreed:—

- (a) that any female, who upon the date of the making of the contract, was under the age of seventeen years completed, should render any menial service to any person for any period exceeding one year, or
- (b) that any payment or other consideration should be made or given to any person, other than the female rendering the menial service, in respect of menial services rendered or to be rendered by any female, who, upon the date of the making of the contract, was under the age of seventeen years completed,

shall be unenforceable in any court after the thirty-first day of August, 1934. Any such contract made after the commencement of this Ordinance shall be unenforceable in any court.
